## February Pre-Public Examinations (mock exams)

Starting on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February, Year 11 students will sit their second and final round of Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs). These exams are important. They will give students valuable experience of exam conditions and identify possible gaps in knowledge and skills. Teachers will use this knowledge to address these gaps in the coming weeks.

These examinations will be run from Monday, 26<sup>th</sup> February to Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> March. Examinations will be conducted in line with the timings and arrangements for the summer examinations: morning examinations will begin at 9am and afternoon ones will begin at 1pm. Please note that all Year 11 students will finish their examinations before 3:20. Students will be allowed to leave school when their examination has finished. If students do not have an afternoon examination, they are to attend their normal lessons.

It is important that Year 11 students leave site promptly after their examinations and go straight home. Although Year 11 students will finish earlier than normal, the usual standard of behaviour still applies, both on- and off-site.

If you would like your child to stay in school until 3.20pm, please let us the office know via email: <a href="mailto:office@ryecollege.co.uk">office@ryecollege.co.uk</a>. Any student, who stays on site, will be expected to attend a revision session on the library. All other year groups will finish at the usual time of 3.20pm.

During the examinations, students who require access arrangements will be provided with these under the supervision of our Exams Officer, Mrs. J. Burgess, and our Inclusion Leader, Mrs. L. Nice.
